Guest Speaker: Mr. Nguyen Dinh Cung

Director of Macroeconomic Policy Department of CIEM
(Central Institute for Economic Management, MPI)

Born in 1959, Mr. Cung got BA on Economics of Trade in Czech Republic in 1982, then Postgraduate Diploma (1993) and M.A. (1996) in Development Economics, University of Manchester, UK. He speaks fluently both English and Czech.

Mr. Cung was one of the key law-makers who got involved in drafting several such important economic and trade legal documents of Vietnam in the last 10 years as: Company and Private Enterprise Law, Bankruptcy Law, Investment Law

and Enterprise Law. Recently, he is key drafter of the Decree on management of business license which is said to be put into effect in this September.

Cung's researches, books and lectures cover a wide range of various economic and legal fields: from macro-economic policies to market economy, from business development service to Enterprise law. He works and conducts research in Germany, Italy, China, the US, Japan, New Zealand and Vietnam.

At this business luncheon, Mr. Cung will share his views with Eurocham members on the pros and cons of the new Common Investment Law, how the business and investors community could most benefit from the law, how the sub-laws, regulations and small licenses that hinder the business development should be reduced.....
