## Consular Club Ho Chi Minh City



The Consular Club of Ho Chi Minh City, founded in 1994, is a non-profit organization. All countries with Consular missions in Ho Chi Minh City are eligible to join.

The Club is non-political and its members meet monthly with the objective of improving the quality of life of disadvantaged groups, principally in southern Viet Nam, by the awarding of grants to projects related to health, education and basic needs.

The main fundraising activities are an annual Charity Bazaar, at which each country has a stall with products typical of that country, and an annual Art Auction, at which original fine art is sold. Funds raised by these activities are distributed according to agreed guidelines.



## Projects awarded grants in the Year 2008



**Mai Lieng Shelter (Binh Thanh District) and Dieu Giac Orphanage (District 2), HCMC**  
Support for English language instruction to girls at Mai Lieng shelter and children raised at Dieu Giac Orphanage. This is a continuation of support from 2007-8 to help children with no prospect of adoption.

**Mai Tam Children's HIV/AIDS Shelter, HCMC**  
Bunk beds for this shelter for children and mothers with HIV/AIDS.



**Congregation of Lovers of the Holy Cross, Cai Mon, Ben Tre**  
Support for food costs for 67 impoverished girls looked after by the nuns. (Ongoing project)

**Clean water for H'mong community in Bao Loc District, Lam Dong Province**  
Contributed funding for the drilling of a well and installing a water purifying system in a remote mountainous area inhabited mainly by the H'mong minority.



**Self-help and Capacity Building Centre for Migrant Workers, Ben Cat, Binh Duong**  
Support for a new project led by St Vincent de Paul Social Services Centre, providing life skills and security for the women and children who have migrated to Binh Duong town for work.

**Be Tho Orphanage, Bien Hoa, Dong Nai**  
Support for basic needs such as rice, food, detergent, mosquito nets and fans as well as school supplies for 126 children. Most are children with disabilities but half of them attend regular school.



**Thien Phuoc House for Disabled Children, Cu Chi District**

Purchase of replacement physiotherapy equipment to be used for the benefit of seriously handicapped children.

**Vocational Training Centre for People with Disabilities and Orphans, Hoc Mon District**

Contributed funding towards the purchase of a generator to ensure electricity supply for a residential training centre providing occupational training to disabled and orphaned young people between the ages of 16-30.

**Chua Dieu Phap Pagoda Orphanage, Bien Hoa, Dong Nai**

Medical checkups for deaf orphans, and funding to buy new cots and wardrobes. (Ongoing project)

**Erigo Library and English Club, Nguyen Cong Tru Secondary School, Xuan Loc, Dong Nai**

Purchase of books and teaching materials. (Ongoing project)

**HCMC Fund for Promoting Education**

Scholarships for five university students in disadvantaged circumstances who are also blind. (Ongoing project)

**An Thoi Dong Community, Can Gio**

Funding for 100 rainwater tanks for poor families. (Ongoing project – the Consular Club has supported this project for 3 years, providing 300 rainwater tanks in total.)

**Bring Poor Pupils Back to School, Dong Son 2 Primary, Dong Son Village, Go Cong Tay, District Tien Giang Province**

Provision of school supplies, including uniforms for 194 students from poor families.

**Thanh Tan Humanitarian School, Vung Tau Province**

Provision of school supplies including school uniforms and a computer for 20-30 children whose family homes were damaged in the typhoon in 2006.



**Pediatric Oncology Ward, HCMC Cancer Centre**

Continuation of basic hygiene project (hand washing) for pediatric patients and donation of computer, printer and fax machine for staff use.

**Sponsoring Association for Poor Patients (SAPP) in HCMC**

Continuation of support for the Cataract Eye surgery for 125 poor patients in cooperation with SAPP and the Charity Eye Clinic. (Ongoing project)

**Humanitarian School /Tu Phuoc Pagoda in Tay Ninh Province**

Free education for 30 children 9-18 years old, who could not otherwise attend school because they are too poor or too old. (Ongoing project - the Consular Club has supported this project for three years.)

**Wells for the People of Luong Nghia Village, Long My District, Hau Giang Province**

Hand pump wells for people in a very poor area, where the current source of drinking water is a polluted river.

**Sesame Bakery Project HCMC**

Purchasing kitchen appliances for new bakery kitchen at Sesame Hospitality School for disadvantaged or former street children of HCMC. (Ongoing project)

**Help Alleviate Poverty in Noorul Ehsaan Village, Hamlet 4, Xuan Hung Commune, Xuan Loc, Dong Nai Province**

Provide funds to mend houses for seven families. The village consists of 585 families from the Champa ethnic minority, most of whom are living in underprivileged conditions.
